

## **IN THE LINE OF DUTY**

Many of the red-seam police officers that I have met, who have served the nation for more than 15 years, have sustained bullet wounds while fighting crime.

Any Jamaican police-officer genuinely wounded in the line of duty should receive a type of national honor. They should receive a special pension as well.

Some senior red-seam officers have been shot and wounded more than ten times. Others have bullets lodged in their spine which cannot be extracted. Others are paraplegics.

There is a tendency to forget the bravery of these courageous men.
